## PROFILE

OF PUBLIC AND RAIL TRANSPORT, is the voice of those working for sustainable mobility. In partnership with trade unions and public and local authorities, it supports projects aimed at improving citizens' quality of life.

The Tramways Union publishes the first issue of its magazine *L'industrie des tramways et chemins de fer.* 

### 1981

The Union of regional and public Transports becomes the **«Union of Public Transports (UTP).»** 





### 2013

Change in the statutes to welcome railway infrastructure managers.

## 2015

UTP joins the **Tourism and Travel Mediation Body MTV** (Médiation Tourisme et Voyage) as a founding member.



## 2017

Creation of two new committees. For the 10th year in a row, the UTP receives the Quali'OP label in recognition of its quality system.

## HISTORY

#### The professional organisation was founded in 1899 after the vote of the Waldeck-Rousseau law on trade unions in 1884. In 1907, the «Tramways

the Waldeck-Rousseau law on trade unions in 1884. In 1907, the «Tramways Union » was renamed to include shortline railways, and then in 1929, to include Railways and Motor Transports. Banned during the Occupation, the Union of Railways (1947) became the Union of

regional and urban public transports, then the Union of Public Transports in 1981. In the context of the opening of rail activities to competition, UTP welcomed railway companies since 2006 and infrastructure managers in 2013. UTP now welcomes all urban transport and rail companies that contribute to sustainable mobility.

### 2004

First European Mobility Exhibition, a joint UTP and GART event. The following year sees them jointly create the GIE Objectif transport public for organising events for the profession.

## 2006

Freight rail transport undertakings join and the name changes: Public and Rail Transport Union.

#### 2012

Membership opens to rail transport undertakings for **international passengers**.



## 2017

Changes to the UTP's statutes, and membership, as partner members, of enterprises working for the benefit of sustainable mobility.

## 2018

ISO 26000 certificate awarded to UTP, «exemplary» level.

Creation of a 8th Committee: **Security and Fight against Fraud**


#### Independence





## URBAN TRANSPORT NETWORKS



Almost **170 urban transport networks** are full members of UTP. They are present throughout France and account for more than 90% of operations nationally. Irrespective of their status, these networks represent the entire sector, given that they run their operations in

agglomerations of all sizes, regardless of the management method (DSP - public service delegation -, internal operator, SPL - local public company -, etc.). As a result, UTP encompasses both modest-sized undertakings and very extensive networks.

UTP reflects the entire rail sector body, as it brings together passenger and freight railway undertakings as well as

infrastructure managers. UTP's full members represent virtually all railway undertakings operating in France.
